

List of projects supported by IWAG in 2016

EDUCATIONAL; grants were given to:

- the FOCUS PROJECT 2016: Technical equipping of three schools in Kvemo Kartli, which is one of the multicultural regions of Georgia.
 - A donation for sport equipment and fire extinguishers in Tandzia; a Georgian school.
 - a grant for sport equipment and for a computer and Xerox in Sopeli Bolnisi; an Armenian school
 - Donation laboratories for Chemistry, physics, Biology and Anatomy in Dzveli Qveshi ; an Azeri school
- the construction of a **Sports Hall/Educational Center** in the village of Zanavi, Adigeni Region .
- **the Association Mkurnali**, to purchase silver and equipment for an enamel workshop, to train and care socially vulnerable children and young people.
- **the Georgian National Film Center** to purchase three Cameras for the project: “Film at School”.
- **the National English spelling competition Georgia (NESC-GE)**. To reward students for excellent performance. In 2016, over 1500 student participated in 11 regions of Georgia. The goal of the competition is, to encourage students and teachers to develop academically, by recognizing their achievements publicly.
- **Tuition fees**; paid to 3 individuals in social deplorable situations

. SOCIAL, grants were given to:

- **the Camillions**; (or Clerics regular; Ministers to the sick) for the equipping of a new logopedic cabinet
- **Catharsis**; International Humanitarian Union to offer free dinner for 310 beneficiaries once a month during 7 months
- **Child, family & society**; kindergarten yard arrangement in Kizilajlo .
Transportation of the most vulnerable children from different sheltering organizations to a charity event ‘COATS’, (Clothing Others Against the Snow) in the Radisson Blu Iveria Hotel, where the children received winter clothing and other essentials.

- **the Club de Chance**; drawing materials, to support the project of the International Drawing Competition for Children “Draw me Peace”
- the **Knitted Knockers** knitting group for handmade knitted breast prostheses
- **Tanadgoma**, Cultural centre for people with disabilities: reconstruction- renovation of the building
- **the Parents Bridge**; for musical instruments
- **St Ilia’s Social Therapy Centre**, for the renovation of a building to open a Weekend School for children and young adults with disabilities.
- **the Rotary Club - for an Infant House**: purchasing of 5 ground-level wheel chairs ("wheelies") for children with spinal bifida.

MEDICAL, grants were given to:

- **Hippocrates (Hellenicare)** — for a Medical Mobile Unit (MMU), portable equipment - EKG, Ultrasound machine and laboratory equipment. Medical Mobile Unit (MMU) travels to different regions of Georgia 9- 10 times per month. MMU consists of doctors of various specialties, who provide free of charge medical services, consultations, diagnostics and free distribution of pharmaceuticals by prescription of MMU doctors.
- **Infant house beneficiaries**, grants, paid for individuals due to their medical needs
- **Medical assistance of 12 individuals**; (check-up, rehabilitation, medication, improvement of the living conditions)
